






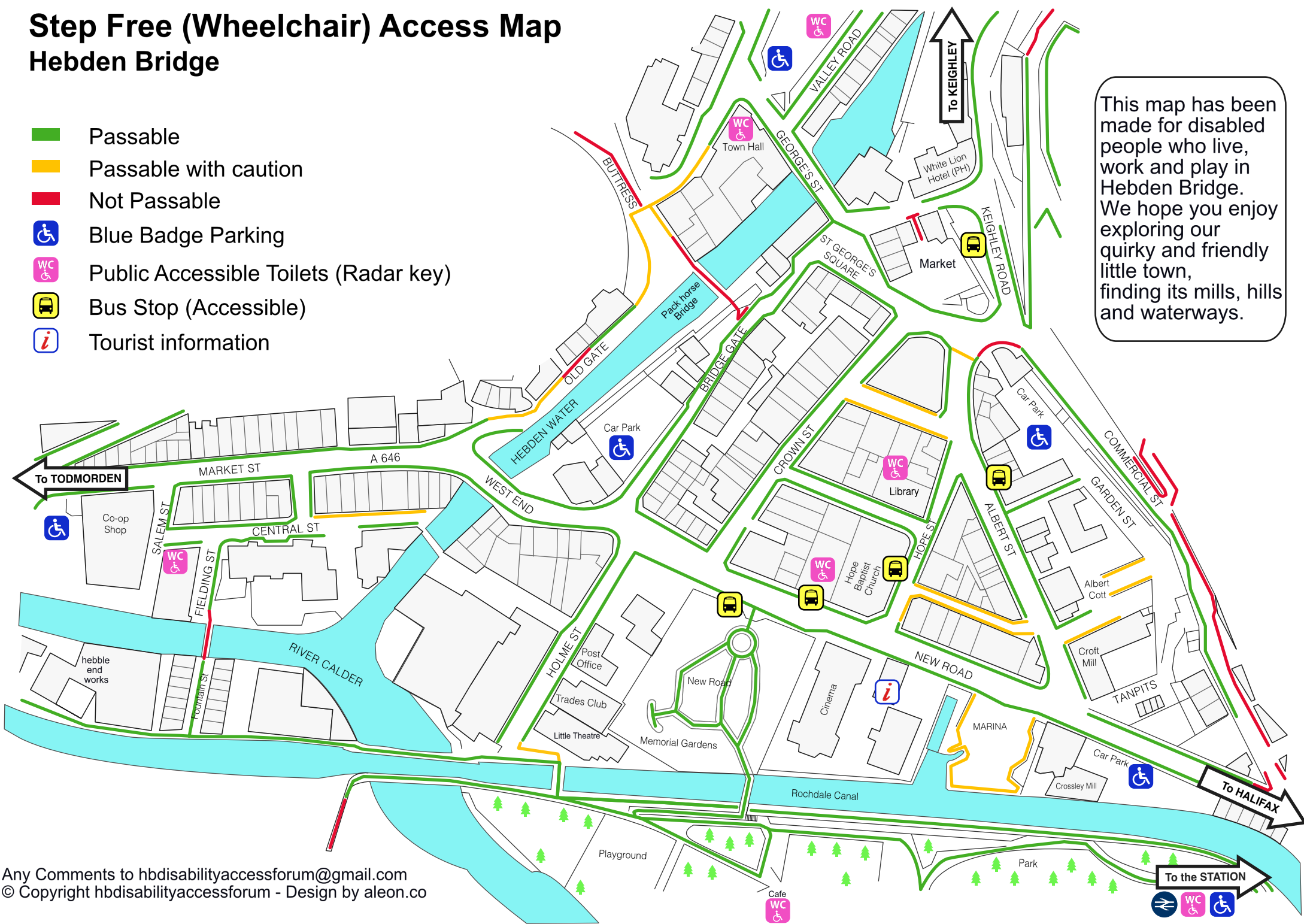


Step Free (Wheelchair) Access Map
